## HOW DO I LEARN MORE ABOUT DODTECHIPEDIA?

The Defense Technical Information Center (DTIC) is conducting workshops to show users how the wiki works, what resources are available through it, and how users can benefit from DoDTechipedia.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND THESE WORKSHOPS?

The target audience includes O3 and above, GS-10 and above, and contractors in the DoD Science & Technology and Acquisition communities.

Attendees should be interested in collaborating with others throughout DoD and Federal communities to bring rapid solutions to technology consumers.

## HOW IS IT TAUGHT?

The DoDTechipedia workshop is a three-hour hands-on experience. Students will engage dynamically in a workshop-long activity while working with an instructor to walk through the basic skills of using the wiki. Ultimately, users will leave with the fundamental skills to support use of DoDTechipedia. Skills covered in the workshop include how to:

- Add a page
- Add a hyperlink
- Embed a graphic
- Use labels
- Edit a page
- Blog

- Extensive exposure to DoDTechipedia
- Hands-on experience to obtain basic wiki skills
- Facilitator who walks through the steps on-screen
